We hope this year to attract a truly global gathering of the best early scholars due to the reduced cost of participation and ease of access.

About ARC

The Andrews Research Conference is organized by the Office of Research and Creative Scholarship at Andrews University. The purpose of the conference is to provide Adventist graduate students, post-docs and early career faculty with the opportunity to share their research and creative scholarship with one another and with Andrews University.

This year, ARC will take place in conjunction with the annual meeting of the Adventist Human-Subject Researchers Association (AHSRA). We encourage you to join ARC (**May 17-18, 2021**) and stay for AHSRA (**May 19-21, 2021**).

In order to enhance the collaboration between ARC and AHSRA participants, papers accepted as oral presentations for ARC will also be accepted for the poster session of AHSRA. Funding support from the General Conference and North American Division of Seventh-day Adventists allow us to offer these conferences at a greatly reduced registration. Early Career researchers will be able to attend both events at the reduced rate of US\$10.00.

Submission Deadline

The submission deadline is **March 31, 2021**. Abstracts and additional materials should be submitted on Digital Commons (see instructions below). The submissions will be reviewed by the Program Committee with notification of acceptance given by **April 15, 2021**.

Submission Requirements

Please submit your abstract through Digital Commons, following the instructions below:

1. Go to <http://digitalcommons.andrews.edu/arc/>. Click "Submit Abstract."
2. Log in or create new account (the account is free).
3. Read the submission instructions and click "Accept."
4. Enter your information into the form.
 - a. Presentation/Event Title. This is the title of your presentation, *not* the conference.
 - b. Please indicate co-authors and their institution under "Presenter Information."

- c. Indicate your title and department affiliation under “Presenter Status” along with the title and department affiliation of any co-authors.
 - d. Format your abstract text in Microsoft Word and enter it in the “Abstract” box.
 - e. Under “Acknowledgments,” list any sources of funding or research scholarships/assistantships received by the authors for this work.
5. You may upload your paper and/or PowerPoint as a PDF to make it publicly available.
 6. Submit the event.
 7. The Program Committee will review your submission and notify you of your acceptance status by **April 15, 2021**. Once accepted, your abstract will be posted to Digital Commons.
