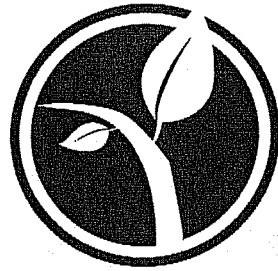

I think that we are finally "coming around" after this whirlwind trip to the other side of the world. It was fabulous! Exhausting! Exhilarating! We experienced so much of Turkish and Russian culture. WOW! The greatest thrill was to see how desperate the Russians are for healing and recovery, and how willing they were to sit through a three day seminar, ask questions through an interpreter, and be very willing to enter the follow-up recovery process. We are in the throws of getting supplies to Russia for translation, so that recovery can begin there. We do have many pictures and varied stories. I am working at writing about all of our experiences, and will bring more in future updates.

For now, I want to tell you about the importance of human touch. The warmth of human touch is something that we all think we understand. Many of us have warm memories of cuddling with Mom, rough-housing with Dad, and hugs and cheek-pinches from relatives at holiday dinners.
