## About the Artist

Colin Fenwick is a Michigan native from Three Rivers. He started his musical career at age 6, studying piano with Jeff Keefer. The following year he began studying violin with Roxane Ewert. At age 8 he joined the “Prep-Strings” orchestra with the Kalamazoo Junior Symphony Society. In 8<sup>th</sup> grade he entered the Kalamazoo Junior Symphony Orchestra where he played until graduating from high school. During this time, he had the opportunity of working with renowned artists such as Midori and Alon Goldstein.

In 9<sup>th</sup> grade Colin began studying both violin and viola with Karen Code, switching fulltime to viola the next year. He studied viola with Patty Kates his junior year and both violin and viola his senior year. He also played in the West Michigan Homeschool Fine Arts Orchestra where he sat as principal violist for two years.

Colin has taken part in several solo masterclasses with pedagogues such as Karen Dreyfus and Heidi Castleman through the Stulberg Competition. He has also participated in chamber music and orchestra workshops, including the Grace Field Chamber workshop and Calvin College String Seminar. His senior year of high school, Colin was a winner of the Arts Council of Greater Kalamazoo’s Bravo! showcase.

Currently, Colin studies violin with Carla Trynchuk and is the violist in a string quartet, as well as alternating principal violist in the Andrews University Symphony Orchestra. He is an active member of the community, playing frequently at retirement homes, as well as church, vespers, and other university functions. Colin plans to continue his studies at Andrews University in the doctoral physical therapy program, where he hopes to make a future career working with musicians.
