The new light green budding leaves and tender shoots of grass remind us that winter's rest is over and it's time to begin again. God's clock is on time and with it He reminds us that we can come alive, we can begin again.


Perhaps you have been hibernating during the winter months, sleeping instead of feeling alive. This can happen in your relationships with others and with God, and He tells us that he is not only the God of creation, but of re-creation as well! Perhaps the atmosphere around us has been cold and unwelcoming since the leaves fell, but the sun has come closer now, days are sunny and warm, and it's time not only to enjoy the sun, but also to bask in the warmth of the "SON."

Often to me, it is a great mystery how leaves and trees can spring up from the poorest of soils and ground, in fact, here in the mountains we often see a pine or pinon tree sprouting out from a tiny crack or crevice in the rock. "How is this even possible?", we ask each other. Even peeking through the snow, tiny daffodil and tulip shoots absolutely amaze us. Ron and I have finally realized that our planting has precious little to do with the successes of those tiny daffodil beginnings, especially when we see pine shoots growing out of a rock. It is always the same power that causes the leaves and daffodils and trees to sprout that also powers our awakening or re-awakening.

"But for you who fear my name the sun of righteousness shall arise, with healing in its wings. You shall go forth leaping like calves from the stall . . ." Malachi 4:2

To be sure, the presence and warmth of the sun can cause the leaves to sprout and the flowers to bloom, and the "Son" can cause healing to bloom within your heart and life. Even though the ground may be unfriendly and unwelcoming, still through the energy God offers, life can spring forth from lifelessness. Even in the dessert, springtime thrills the inhabitants with multi-colored wildflowers. There has been, in most cases, very little nourishing water and not much in the way of fertilizing substance to encourage the growth, but still in God's universe, beauty comes forth from nothing. This being the case, why is it so difficult to fathom that the same God who causes beauty to grow all around us, can cause that beauty to spring forth within us? What prevents us from seeing endless possibilities for beauty in our personal lives and in our relationships?





Often the frustration we feel in our lives now, is the result of earlier experiences of religious frustration. Maybe you were raised in a family where religion or spirituality was ignored, frowned upon or even totally discounted. Or just the opposite, you might have been raised in a family where religion and rigid standards were harshly enforced, and you felt imprisoned by the fact that you were a child and someone else was in control. You may have decided to swing, like a pendulum, to the other side – to be free as a bird and totally in charge of your behaviors, your choices and your comings and goings. If that's the case, could it be that resistance to things spiritual (notice that we didn't say religious) is keeping you from the relationship that would bring to you the greatest peace, love and joy?

Perhaps you had a parent, especially father, whose attitudes and behaviors were far from loving or accepting. If so, you interpreted that God is anything but loving too. Why? - because parents stand in the place of God to their children when they are below the age of seven. The way you saw and experienced your parents would be the way you believe regarding God.

Maybe you once believed and attended a church or synagogue regularly, but the pastor or rabbi or the people who attended there were not representative of the true loving character of God. You may have felt like the "odd man out" or that you did not belong. Maybe there were cliques who did not include you or perhaps you felt that the hypocrisy of the "saints" was too much to bear. Look at the scandals that have rocked

the religious world – sexual inappropriateness or abuse has raised its ugly head in most denominations and has nearly financially ruined some Catholic churches. Were you a victim of such abuse?

There is a blunder that many people make. They equate God with the people who supposedly represent Him. That's a whopping mistake! God is without flaw, without sin, and people (church members or not) are sin-filled, thanks to our original earthly father - Adam., Yup, those people who sit or sat near you in the church pews had beginnings too, and they may have received more damage from them than you did from yours. And so, they like you are simply living out the results of their wounds - using their own poorly concocted survival techniques (living out of their survival brains rather than loving hearts) and trying to make it from one day to the other. Unfortunately, some of these survival techniques wound those who use them and those around them.

One more thing that needs to be considered here is that Satan, God's enemy has an agenda. It is to see to it that you are separated from God so that you cannot feel his love and his acceptance of you. He uses the circumstances of life and the people with whom you relate or have related in the past, to wound and teach you the opposite of God's love. You have the ability to submit to God's agenda for your life, which is to bring you abundant joy in relationship with him, or to choose to allow the enemy to have his way with you. His cunning ways are so subtle that it is difficult to see that he is orchestrating the circumstances of your life to separate you from all of the people and experiences that can verify God's power in your life and His love for you. One of his favorite games is to play divide and conquer. He does this in marriages, in parent/child relationships and in so doing, he discourages and disappoints leaving us discouraged and feeling hopeless.

Consider this as we have experienced yet another season of multi-colored stuffed rabbits, ducks, lambs and chicks and chocolate this n' that, colored eggs and big dinners. Remember what is really supposed to be represented in this Easter season – the resurrected and risen Christ. Recall what Paul said in Romans 6:4... "Therefore we were buried with Him in baptism unto death, in order that, like as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory (goodness and mercy) of the Father, .even so we may walk in newness of life."

May God grant you the strength to move past the roadblocks in your life to having the risen Lord reside in your heart and experience, is our prayer.
