





Highest education (SDA)







Household Sabbath observance







Congregants in Larger Churches

•Are more highly educated congregants

- •Have engaged in more SDA education
- •Have larger families or number of people in household and larger number of those who keep Sabbath
- •More often report that they are more likely to continue SDA membership (while statistically significant the percentages show only small differences)
- •Engage in more religious routines (worship, radio, bible study)
- •Engage more frequently with ministries (giving and helping) and with other church members
- •Report stronger levels of agreement with SDA fundamental beliefs
- •Are more satisfied with their local church
- •Are not satisfied with the status quo. They want their church to do better and grow more.
